When former English professor Patricia Mendius developed Macular Degeneration, it was devastating.

"I spent my whole life reading," she said. "I love to read...and then that was taken away from me. You feel robbed of your ability to read."

When she found out how much it helped to use a reading magnifier she did everything she could to make these machines available to the 1,000 + people in Los Alamos and White Rock who suffer from Macular Degeneration.

When she told the Board of the Friends of the Mesa Public Library about the reading magnifiers, we bought four: two for Los Alamos

and two for the White Rock Branch.

We were able to do this, and much more, because of the generosity of the people in the community who have donated books to the used bookstore and contributed to our Endowment Fund.

The Friends of the Mesa Public Library is a non-profit organization that was established in 1978 to support the library and help further its mission.

We do this by funding things like:

- Special events
- Gallery shows
- Book group kits
- Books and honoraria for the Authors Speak series
- After-school tutor program

Over the years we have annually spent between \$45-50,000 making the library a more enriching place

for everyone. Sometimes we can do even more.

We also offer support beyond the library to important programs like the Jail Library, regional rural libraries and the annual scholarship program.
